Old Dominion University, located in Norfolk, is Virginia's forward-focused public doctoral research university with more than 24,000 students, rigorous academics, an energetic residential community and initiatives that contribute \$2.6 billion annually to Virginia's economy.

CUSTOMER REQUIREMENT

A centralized recorder needed to be integrated into the university's existing IT infrastructure that can simultaneously record, store and share Microsoft Teams, Zoom and WebEx video conferences.

CHALLENGE

Using solely general video conferencing solutions is not suitable for distance learning. The university needed an additional recorder that is sophisticated, compliant and can be integrated not only with ODU's infrastructure but with MS Teams, WebEx, Zoom and other third-party solutions, such as Kaltura.

SOLUTION

TC&C developed CARIN LectureRecorder, a vendor-independent, centralized media recorder and sharing application that is specialized for distance learning and provides everything the university needs. This includes recording MS Teams, WebEx and Zoom in 4k. The system is capable of recording the presenter and the shared media simultaneously with customizable layout options. Speech-to-text is available as well as the possibility to generate downloadable notes from transcriptions. Users can schedule recording due to the Outlook integration. Recorded materials are accessible via a unified and user-friendly platform (CARIN Publishing Server) in a secure and traceable way.
